McKinley Heights is a true Community Garden. There are no membership fees or fences. The entire garden is intended to be a shared space, from the beds to the fruit trees.

The Garden has **13 PLANTING BEDS** which have had a variety of produce. Over the years we have planted tomatoes, potatoes, onions, garlic, okra, asparagus, carrots, radishes, beans, peppers, lettuce, just to name a few. There are also fruits in the garden; apples, pears, blackberries, cherries, apricots, grapes, and figs! Plus one bed designated just for herbs!

McKinley Meadows has been a wonderful host for several neighborhood events! The location and atmosphere have provided opportunities for local artist to share their work with Movie nights and paper making! A local musical artisan group incorporated the plants into their performance. During the summer of 2021 the Garden Hosted it's first Comedy night! We even have a lending library!

In our 10 years, we have had the pleasure to introduce neighbors young and older to new foods, first time tastes, and the delight of participating.
